The Decatur County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on March 26, 2018, at 8:00 a.m. in the Board Room of the Decatur County Courthouse. Present: Robert Bell, Dan Christensen and Jim Fulton. Also present was Stephanie Daughton, County Auditor. Unless otherwise noted, all motions carried unanimously.

Motion Bell/Christensen to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion Bell/Christensen to approve the minutes of the March 19, 2018, regular session. Motion carried.

Conservation Director Rich Erke met with the Board to discuss a wetland mitigation project at the north end of the lake. The project was the result of the pipeline company being required to rebuild or replace what they disturbed following necessary pipeline repairs. Erke said a location south of J20 was selected.
