May 21, 2018

The Decatur County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on May 21, 2018, at 8:00 a.m. in the Board Room of the Decatur County Courthouse. Present: Bob Bell, Dan Christensen and Jim Fulton. Also present was Stephanie Daughton, County Auditor. Unless otherwise noted, all motions carried unanimously.

Motion Bell/Christensen to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion Christensen/Bell to approve the minutes of the May 14, 2018, regular session. Motion carried.

Attorney James Rowe, of the Law Offices of Verle Norris, met with the Board to discuss Garden Grove parcel 0428475014. It was determined that the last conveyance of the entire parcel was by tax deed in June 1949 to Decatur County, though it was always assumed to have been part of any conveyances of adjoining parcels since that time. Rowe requested a deed from the County to his client so that the septic could be inspected and the property sold. Motion Bell/Christensen to convey to Rowe's client the portion of the parcel that extends to the western boundary of her property directly to the north, and convey to the adjoining neighbor to the west the remainder of the parcel. Motion carried.

Motion Christensen/Bell to approve the FY19 Cass County Child Support Staffing Contract between the Cass County (Host), Political Subdivision and the Department of Human Services – Bureau of Collections and to authorize Chairman Fulton to sign same. Motion carried.

Assistant County Engineer Dillon Davenport met with the Board to discuss departmental matters. Also in attendance was Assistant to the County Engineer Noah Thomas. The partial payment to Herberger Construction, BRS-C027(57)—60-27 was tabled until next week, as paperwork has not yet been received.

Sheriff Ben Boswell and Leon Chief of Police Jason Weir met with the Board with additional information for continued discussion regarding law enforcement and coverage for Leon.

Holly Rash and Shelley Bickel met with the Board regarding the Homemaker Program.

With no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 3:00 p.m.
