June 11, 2018

The Decatur County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on June 11, 2018, at 8:00 a.m. in the Board Room of the Decatur County Courthouse. Present: Bob Bell, Dan Christensen and Jim Fulton. Also present was Stephanie Daughton, County Auditor. Unless otherwise noted, all motions carried unanimously.

Motion Christensen/Bell to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion Christensen/Bell to approve the minutes of the June 6, 2018, regular session. Motion carried.

Motion Christensen/Bell to approve Kay Herring's request (on behalf of the Decatur County Democrats) to use the courthouse lawn on Thursday, July 12. Motion carried.

Veterans Affairs Administrator Samantha Schaff met with the Board to inform them that Eldon Binning will be resigning from the VA Commission Board effective June 30, 2018, and provided names of individuals who had expressed a willingness to be appointed when the vacancy occurs.
